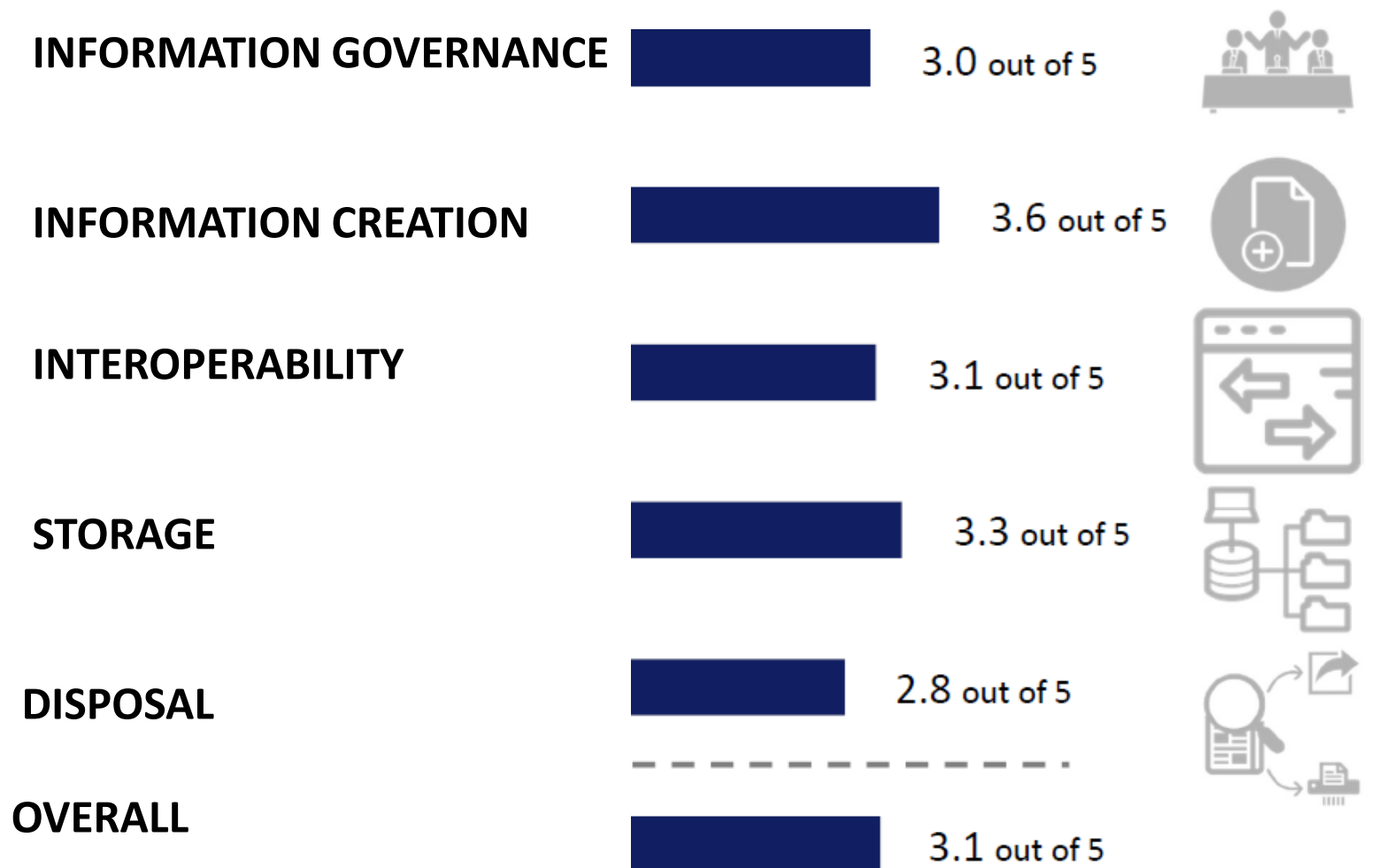

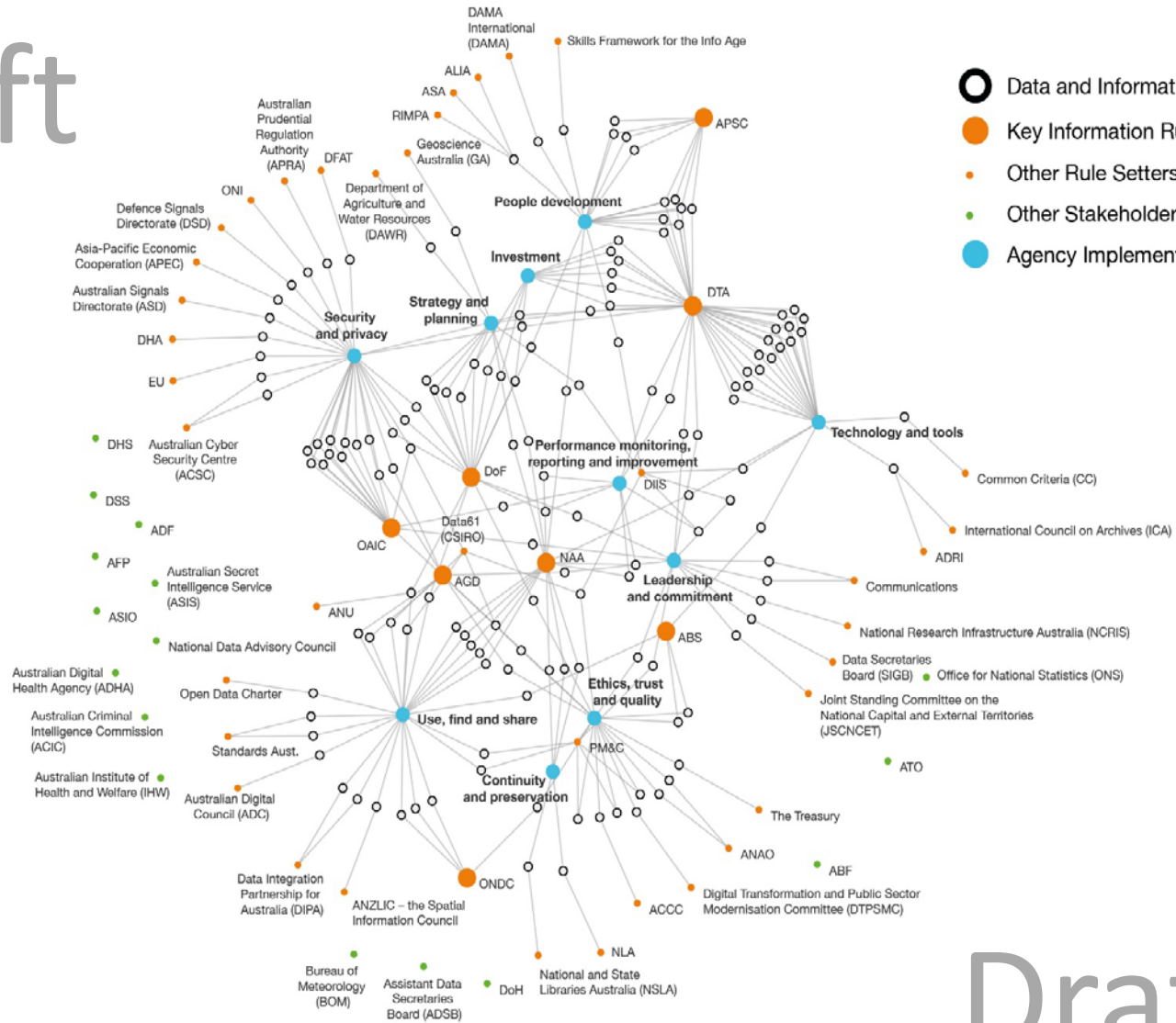
New Policy from 2021

- Trust and accountability focus

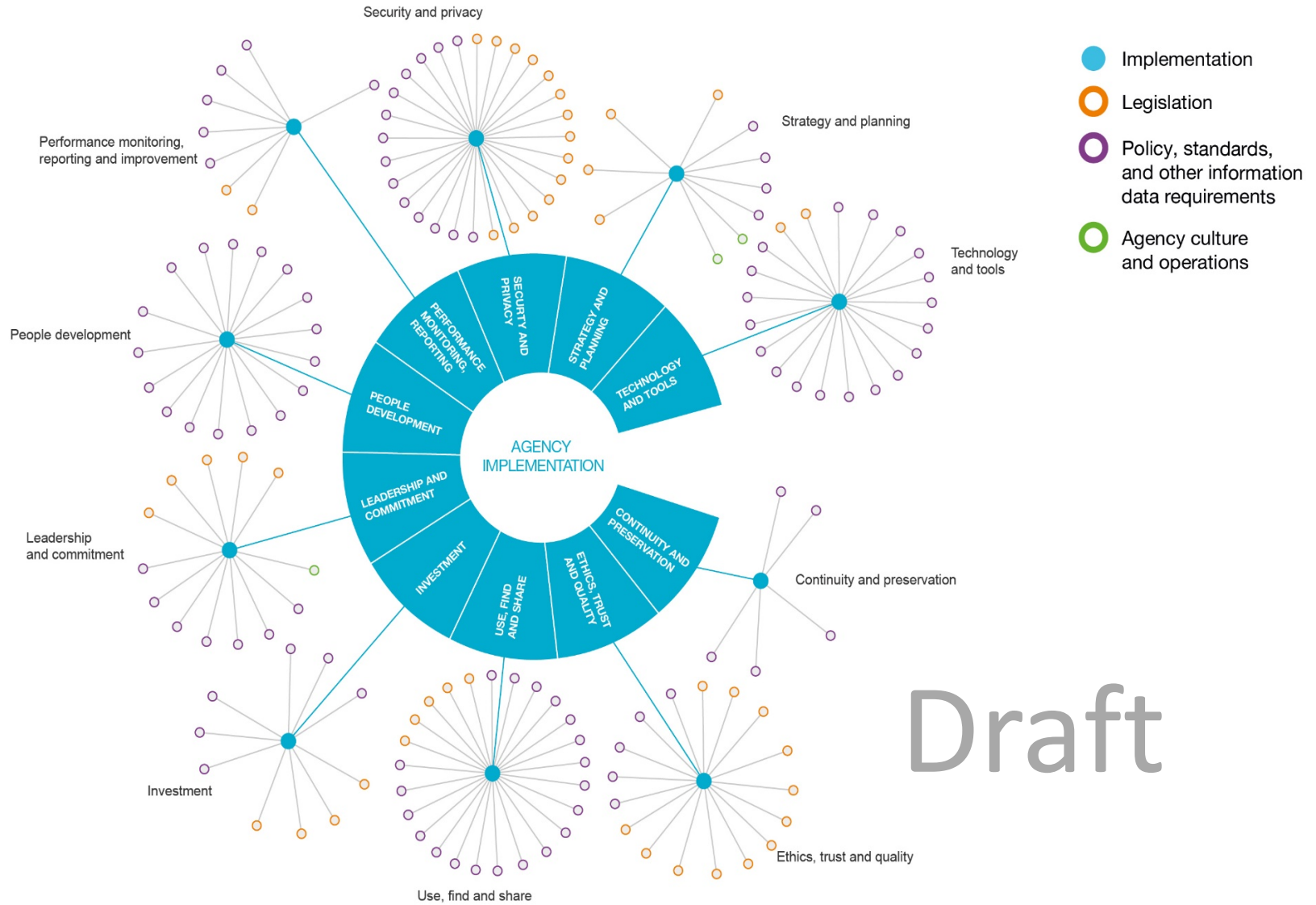
Why?
